Responsibilities

- Willingness to engage in the entirety of the Public Health Leadeship Summer Institute and Premedical Academy, from approximately 9 AM to 6 PM in one of the locations: Boston, MA, Washington, D.C., and/or Los Angeles, CA.
- Ability to chaperone and escort high school participants of the institute and academy during the 5 days, including meals and other activities; will be in charge of a maximum of 20 students
- Ensuring high school students make the **10 PM curfew**
- Assembling students at the beginning of each day and taking attendance throughout the day
- Assuming a role in the BCPH Advisory Council for the institute and academy as needed (e.g. student conduct reviews)
- Assisting with chaperoning during college campus or medical school tours, site-seeing tours, etc.
- □ Assisting with other miscellaneous administrative tasks as needed
