

BCPH Public Health Grant Program

1. Purpose and Objectives

• **Purpose**: To support and encourage innovative public health projects and initiatives by BCPH members that address pressing health challenges and promote positive community impact.

Objectives:

- o Provide financial assistance to members for impactful public health projects.
- Encourage BCPH members to engage in community-based health initiatives.
- o Foster innovation and creativity in addressing public health issues.

2. Grant Criteria

Eligibility:

- Must be a BCPH Essential or Elite Member for at least 6 months prior to the application opening date.
- Individual grant seekers must be BCPH members.
- o Group grant seekers must have at least 2 BCPH members.
- Open to individuals or teams with a demonstrated commitment to public health.

Selection Criteria:

- Project Relevance: The project addresses a significant public health issue.
- Innovation: The approach is creative and demonstrates innovative thinking.
- **Impact**: Potential for positive impact on public health outcomes.
- Feasibility: The project is realistic and achievable within the proposed timeline and budget. BCPH encourages projects that can be obtained within 6 months to 1 year of receipt of grant.
- Sustainability: Plans for long-term impact and continuation beyond the grant period.
- **Judging Process:** Applications will be evaluated based on the criteria above, with each criterion receiving equal weight. A panel of judges will review and score each submission.

3. Grant Categories and Amounts

- BCPH Essential Members: Eligible for grants ranging from \$250 to \$500.
- **BCPH Elite Members:** Eligible for grants ranging from \$750 to \$1,500.

4. Application Process

Submission Requirements:

- Completed application form
- o Project proposal (including objectives, methodology, expected outcomes, and budget)
- Statement of relevance to public health through the lenses of justice and equity
- Timeline and project milestones

Format and Guidelines:

- Submissions must be in PDF format and not exceed 2,000 words.
- o Budget should be detailed and justified, showing how funds will be allocated.

Application Timeline:

Opens: October 1, 2024Closes: December 31, 2024

5. Judging Panel

- **Panel Composition:** A diverse group of experts in public health, including practitioners, academics, and previous grant winners.
- Selection Process: Judges will be selected based on their expertise and experience in public health and related fields.

6. Grant Benefits

- Funding: Financial support for public health projects, with grant amounts varying based on membership level.
- Recognition: Grant recipients will be featured on the BCPH website and in the BCPH newsletter.
- Publication: Results from the research will be published free-of-charge in The Boston Congress of Public Health Review

7. Timeline

Application Period:

Opens: October 1, 2024Closes: December 31, 2024

Judging Period: January 5 - January 20, 2025
Award Announcement: February 1, 2025

8. Terms and Conditions

• Legal Requirements:

- Agreement to terms and conditions
- Consent to publish project outcomes on BCPH platforms

Disqualification Rules:

- Incomplete applications
- Non-compliance with submission guidelines
- Members who have not met the 6-month membership requirement
